A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award by the Ohio Department of Youth Services of a Title II formula grant for a Juvenile Court Diversion Program, for the period 1/1/12 through 12/31/12, in the amount of \$103,232.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating these federal funds for expenditures in calendar year 2012, for the County of Summit Juvenile Court, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Youth Services has awarded a Title II formula grant to the County of Summit Juvenile Court, for the period 1/1/12 through 12/31/12, in the amount of \$103,232.00, with no local cash match requirement, for a diversion program; and

WHEREAS, this is the fourth year of funding for this diversion program, which will serve approximately 200 youths and is focused on African American and other minorities in the 10-17 age range; and

WHEREAS, this grant will provide funding for Juvenile Court case management services and for contracted services with Greenleaf for further assessments, planning, counseling, and treatment for this population; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the Ohio Department of Youth Services, and to appropriate these grant funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept the Title II formula grant award of federal funds from the Ohio Department of Youth Services, for the period 1/1/12 through 12/31/12, in the amount of \$103,232.00, with no local cash match requirement.
