7 **A Resolution authorizing a super blanket encumbrance, subject to the approval of the**
8 **Board of Control, to pay agencies in the communities of Stow, Silver Lake, Peninsula,**
9 **Barberton, Boston Heights, Akron, Richfield, Springfield and New Franklin assigned by**
10 **the Ohio Department of Public Safety to the Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated**
11 **Task Force, in an amount not to exceed \$104,229.37, for the period 10/1/11 to 9/30/12, for**
12 **the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety ("ODPS"), through the Governor's
15 Highway Safety Office, offers funding for a countywide Operating a Motor Vehicle While
16 Intoxicate ("OVI") Task Force program in the County of Summit; and

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18 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Sheriff's Office has been awarded \$198,449.88, with
19 no local cash match requirement, for the period 10/1/11 to 9/30/12, to create a countywide OVI
20 Task Force program to conduct high visibility enforcement, public awareness, and education for
21 alcohol-related crashes and traffic-related fatalities in Summit County; and

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23 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2011-424, which authorized
24 the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the OVI grant and
25 appropriated the grant funds; and

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27 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all at its October 13, 2010
28 meeting, the Board of Control awarded a super blanket encumbrance to pay agencies in the
29 communities of Stow, Silver Lake, Peninsula, Barberton, Boston Heights, Akron Richfield,
30 Springfield and New Franklin assigned by the ODPS to the OVI Task Force, in an amount not to
31 exceed \$104,229.37, to be paid out of OVI Task Force grant funds; and

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33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
34 of Ohio, that:

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36 SECTION 1

37 A super blanket encumbrance is hereby authorized, subject to the approval of the Board
38 of Control, to pay agencies in the communities of Stow, Silver Lake, Peninsula, Barberton,
39 Boston Heights, Akron, Richfield, Springfield and New Franklin assigned by the Ohio
40 Department of Public Safety ("ODPS") to the Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated
41 ("OVI") Task Force, in an amount not to exceed \$104,229.37, to be paid out of \$198,449.88 in
42 federal funds awarded by ODPS to the County Sheriff, with no local cash match requirement, for
43 the period 10/1/11 to 9/30/12.
