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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a collective bargaining**
8 **agreement between Local 1032 (Service and Maintenance Unit) and Ohio Council 8 of the**
9 **American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees ("AFSCME"), AFL-CIO,**
10 **and the County of Summit and the County Engineer, for the period 4/1/12 through 3/31/15,**
11 **for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, a collective bargaining agreement has been reached between Local 1032
14 (Service and Maintenance Unit) and Ohio Council 8 of the American Federation of State, County
15 and Municipal Employees ("AFSCME"), AFL-CIO, and the County of Summit and the County
16 Engineer, for the period 4/1/12 through 3/31/15; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that
19 authorizing the County Executive to execute the aforementioned collective bargaining agreement
20 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
23 of Ohio, that:

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25 SECTION 1

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27 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a collective bargaining agreement
28 between Local 1032 (Service and Maintenance Unit) and Ohio Council 8 of the American
29 Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees ("AFSCME"), AFL-CIO, and the County
30 of Summit and the County Engineer, for the period 4/1/12 through 3/31/15.

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32 SECTION 2

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the for the further purpose of providing a
36 timely collective bargaining agreement between Local 1032 (Service and Maintenance Unit) and
37 Ohio Council 8 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees
38 ("AFSCME"), AFL-CIO, and the County of Summit and the County Engineer, for the period
39 4/1/12 through 3/31/15.

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41 SECTION 3

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
