7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a**
8 **professional service contract with Akron Area YMCA, to provide one-to-one, adult-to-**
9 **youth mentoring services for adjudicated youth involved with the court, in an amount not**
10 **to exceed \$8,000.00 (94% increase), for the Court of Common Pleas Juvenile Division, and**
11 **declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held April 4, 2012, awarded Change
14 Order No. 1 to a professional service contract with Akron Area YMCA, to provide one-to-one,
15 adult-to-youth mentoring services for adjudicated youth involved with the court, in an amount
16 not to exceed \$8,000.00 (94% increase), subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, by reviewing all pertinent information,
19 that the change order is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
22 of Ohio, that:

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24 SECTION 1

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26 The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a professional service
27 contract with Akron Area YMCA, to provide one-to-one, adult-to-youth mentoring services for
28 adjudicated youth involved with the court, in an amount not to exceed \$8,000.00 (94% increase),
29 is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such change
30 order.

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32 SECTION 2

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
36 provide youth mentoring services.

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38 SECTION 3

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40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


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46 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
