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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with Brite**  
8 **Computers for fifteen Fujitsu mobile data terminals, for law enforcement agencies in Ohio**  
9 **Homeland Security Region 5, under the Western States Contracting Alliance between**  
10 **Fujitsu and the State of Ohio, approved by the IT Board on 3/13/12, in an amount not to**  
11 **exceed \$50,295.00, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk**  
12 **Management – Division of Public Safety/Emergency Management Agency, and declaring**  
13 **an emergency.**

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15 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held March 14, 2012, awarded a  
16 purchase order with Brite Computers for fifteen Fujitsu mobile data terminals, for law  
17 enforcement agencies in Ohio Homeland Security Region 5, under the Western States  
18 Contracting Alliance between Fujitsu and the State of Ohio, approved by the IT Board on  
19 3/13/12, in an amount not to exceed \$50,295.00; and

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21 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
22 that the purchase order is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
25 of Ohio, that:

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27 SECTION 1

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29 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with Brite Computers for fifteen  
30 Fujitsu mobile data terminals, for law enforcement agencies in Ohio Homeland Security Region  
31 5, under the Western States Contracting Alliance between Fujitsu and the State of Ohio,  
32 approved by the IT Board on 3/13/12, in an amount not to exceed \$50,295.00, is hereby  
33 confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase order.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
38 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately ensure  
39 expenditure of grant funds within the grant period.

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


