7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a purchase order with Siemens**
8 **Healthcare Diagnostics, Inc., subject to the approval of the Board of Control, for various**
9 **reagents and use of the Syva Viva Jr. analyzer for toxicology screenings, as Best Practical**
10 **Source, for three years, in an amount not to exceed \$14,120.64 per year, for a total amount**
11 **not to exceed \$42,361.92 for three years, for the Medical Examiner, and declaring an**
12 **emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, it is necessary to execute a purchase order with Siemens Healthcare
15 Diagnostics, Inc., subject to the approval of the Board of Control, for various reagents and use of
16 the Syva Viva Jr. analyzer for toxicology screenings, as Best Practical Source, for three years, in
17 an amount not to exceed \$14,120.64 per year, for a total amount not to exceed \$42,361.92 for
18 three years; and

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20 WHEREAS, County Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information, that
21 the Executive should be authorized to execute the aforementioned purchase order with Siemens
22 Healthcare Diagnostics, Inc., subject to the approval of the Board of Control;

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24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
25 of Ohio, that:

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27 SECTION 1

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29 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a purchase order with Siemens
30 Healthcare Diagnostics, Inc., subject to the approval of the Board of Control, for various reagents
31 and use of the Syva Viva Jr. analyzer for toxicology screenings, as Best Practical Source, for
32 three years, in an amount not to exceed \$14,120.64 per year, for a total amount not to exceed
33 \$42,361.92.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
38 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
39 provide the reagents and analyzer for screenings.

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

7 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
8 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
