8 **contract with the County of Summit Clerk of Courts Office for IV-D provider services for**
9 **reimbursement of filing services and expenses related to Child Support Enforcement**
10 **Agency child support filings, for the period 1/1/12 through 12/31/12, in an amount not to**
11 **exceed \$205,141.66, for the Prosecutor – Child Support Enforcement Agency, and**
12 **declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held March 7, 2012, awarded a
15 professional service contract with the County of Summit Clerk of Courts Office for IV-D
16 provider services for reimbursement of filing services and expenses related to Child Support
17 Enforcement Agency child support filings, for the period 1/1/12 through 12/31/12, in an amount
18 not to exceed \$205,141.66, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
21 that the aforementioned contract is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
24 of Ohio, that:

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26 SECTION 1

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28 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with the County of
29 Summit Clerk of Courts Office for IV-D provider services for reimbursement of filing services
30 and expenses related to Child Support Enforcement Agency child support filings, for the period
31 1/1/12 through 12/31/12, in an amount not to exceed \$205,141.66, is hereby confirmed and the
32 County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such contract.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose of immediately
38 providing these services for the period beginning 1/1/12.

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40 SECTION 3

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

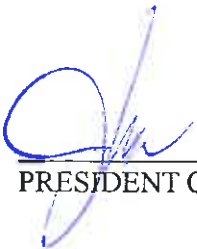
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48 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating

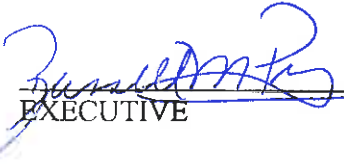
