7 **A Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**
8 **Summit, entitled "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to authorize the County Executive to hire**
9 **externally one person into a full-time, bargaining, classified, Electronic Instrument**
10 **Technician position, at an hourly rate not to exceed \$20.77, for the Executive's Department**
11 **of Environmental Services and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2009-110, which enacted
14 Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Temporary
15 Hiring Freeze," to control and reduce the County's budget deficit, and Ordinance No. 2011-204,
16 which reinstated the hiring freeze through December 31, 2012; and

17
18 WHEREAS, Section 169.04(j) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that
19 the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and
20 continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a resolution authorizing the office to hire
21 said employees; and

23 WHEREAS, the Executive states that the Department of Environmental Services has only
24 two Electronic Instrument Technicians in its workforce, that one position of Electronic
25 Instrument Technician positions will be vacant due to a retirement beginning on December 31,
26 2012, and that the position has been posted internally and applications were received and
27 reviewed; and

29 WHEREAS, no internal applicants met the minimum qualifications of the position of
30 Electrician II; and

32 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
33 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
34 Executive to hire one external person into a full-time, bargaining, classified, Electronic
35 Instrument Technician position at an hourly rate not to exceed \$20.77;

37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,

42 County Council hereby determines that the County Executive's Department of
43 Environmental Services has demonstrated that it is necessary for the effective and continued
44 operation of his office to authorize the County Executive, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the
45 Codified Ordinances, to hire one external person into a full-time, bargaining, classified,
46 Electronic Instrument Technician position at an hourly rate not to exceed \$20.77.

7 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
8 authorize the County Executive to hire said person in order to continue to effectively operate and
9 maintain the County's waste water treatment plants and pump stations.

13 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
14 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect
15 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

20 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
21 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
