7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a Local Public Agency**  
8 **agreement with the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Transportation, for the**  
9 **improvement of Riverview Road, located in Boston Township, Council District 1, at a cost**  
10 **not to exceed \$550,000.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

11  
12 WHEREAS, the public interest of the County of Summit requires the improvement of  
13 Riverview Road from the Village of Peninsula north corporate line to Boston Mills Road (C.H.  
14 32), including restoring the road surface, improving the road shoulders, repairing the road base  
15 where required, ditching, reconstructing catch basins, pavement marking, and upgrading  
16 guardrail, Project Identification ("PID") Number 93815, located in Boston Township, ("Project");  
17 and

18  
19 WHEREAS, the Project's estimated cost for construction, construction engineering, and  
20 inspection contingencies is \$550,000.00; and

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22 WHEREAS, the Federal Metropolitan Planning Organization's ("MPO") Surface  
23 Transportation Program ("STP") funds have been awarded to the County Engineer for a grant to  
24 cover the 80% of the Project's construction cost with a 20% local cash match requirement; and

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26 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") and the Engineer desire  
27 to enter into a Local Public Agency ("LPA") agreement, to confirm the Project's construction  
28 cost and to designate the County of Summit as the lead agency for administration of competitive  
29 bidding, construction and construction engineering of the Project; and

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31 WHEREAS, Sections 5501.03 (c) and 5543.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, as well as  
32 Section 2.03 (5) of the County of Summit Charter, allow execution of such agreements, subject  
33 to the approval of County Council; and

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35 WHEREAS, said LPA Agreement will state ODOT shall provide to the LPA  
36 \$440,000.00 in eligible costs from MPO STP funds; and

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38 WHEREAS, no funds will be expended for the Project's construction until and unless  
39 authorized by separate resolution; and

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41 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
42 that authorizing the County Executive to enter into the aforementioned LPA agreement with  
43 ODOT is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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45 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
46 of Ohio, that:  
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4 SECTION 1

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6 The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into a Local Public Agency  
7 agreement with the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Transportation, for the  
8 improvement of Riverview Road, Project Identification No. 93815, located in Boston Township,  
9 Council District 1.

10  
11 SECTION 2

12 The terms of said agreement shall include the following:

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- 15 a. That the parties estimate the Project's cost to be \$550,000.00, with said cost including  
16 construction engineering and inspection;
  - 17  
18 b. That LPA shall provide \$440,000.00 in Federal MPO STP funds with a local match  
19 requirement of \$110,000.00 from the Motor Vehicle and Gas Tax fund;
  - 20  
21 c. That the County of Summit shall provide all other financial resources necessary to  
22 fully complete the Project;
  - 23  
24 d. That, upon receipt of federal authorization from ODOT, the County may commence  
25 competitive bidding activities for Project construction, with award of contract subject  
26 to applicable County of Summit Ordinances, said ordinances requiring authorization  
27 of such an award by this Council.

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29 SECTION 3

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31 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
32 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it completes a  
33 prerequisite for a road improvement in Boston Township that is immediately needed for safe and  
34 convenient travel within the County.

35  
36 SECTION 4

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38 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
39 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
40 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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42 SECTION 5

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44 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
45 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
46 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
47 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
48 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
