7 **An amended Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a contract with**
8 **Medical Mutual of Ohio, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, to serve as the**
9 **County's pharmacy benefits manager and to administer a mail-order prescription program**
10 **on behalf of the County, for the period of January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013, with**
11 **two options to renew for a one-year term, for the Executive's Department of Law,**
12 **Insurance and Risk Management, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, after issuing a request for proposals, the County of Summit selected Medical
15 Mutual of Ohio ("Medco") to serve as the County's pharmacy benefits manager and to
16 administer a mail-order prescription program on behalf of the County, for the period of January
17 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013, with two options to renew for a one-year term; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
20 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to execute a
21 contract with Medco to serve as the County's pharmacy benefits manager and to serve as the
22 administrator of a mail-order prescription program on behalf of the County;

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24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
25 State of Ohio, that:

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27 SECTION 1

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29 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Medical Mutual of
30 Ohio ("Medco"), subject to the approval of the Board of Control, to serve as the County's
31 pharmacy benefits manager and to administer a mail-order prescription program on behalf of the
32 County, for the period of January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013, with two options to renew
33 for a one-year term.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
38 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately enter
39 into said agreement so that the County has a pharmacy benefits manager and mail-order
40 prescription program in place when the contract with the current provider expires on 12/31/12.

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42 SECTION 3

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44 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
45 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
46 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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4 SECTION 4

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6 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
7 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
8 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
9 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
10 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
