7 **An amended Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents**  
8 **necessary to accept a 2012-2013 Victims of Crime Act grant award, in the amount of**  
9 **\$31,434.00, with a local cash match requirement of \$7,864.00, along with an additional**  
10 **supplement of \$18,448.14 ~~\$18,488.14~~ in Title IV-E funds, for a total of \$57,746.14, and a**  
11 **2012-2013 State Victims Assistance Act grant award, in the amount of \$3,286.00, with no**  
12 **local cash match requirement, both from the Ohio Office of the Attorney General, for the**  
13 **period 10/1/12 through 9/30/13, and appropriating the total of the Victims of Crime Act**  
14 **and State Victims Assistance Act 2012-2013 Program funding in the amount of \$61,032.14**  
15 **~~\$60,032.14~~ through 12/31/12 for the Court of Common Pleas – Juvenile Division, and**  
16 **declaring an emergency.**

18 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Juvenile Court has been awarded a 2012-2013  
19 Victims of Crime Act (“VOCA”) grant, to help support a volunteer coordinator staff position, in  
20 the amount of \$31,434.00, with a local cash match requirement of \$7,864.00, which has been  
21 provided for in an appropriation within the Juvenile Court’s annual budget as set forth in  
22 Resolution No. 2011-483; and

24 WHEREAS, an additional supplement from Title IV-E funds in the amount of  
25 \$18,448.14 ~~\$18,488.14~~ is required in order to fully cover salary and benefits for this volunteer  
26 coordinator position which will coordinate the services that are provided to child abuse victims  
27 by the Court Appointed Special Advocate (“CASA”) child volunteer advocates and the Court  
28 child advocates; and

30 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Juvenile Court has been awarded a 2012-2013 State  
31 Victims Assistance Act (“SVAA”) grant, in the amount of \$3,286.00, with no local cash match  
32 requirement, for various expenses in program supplies and contract services; and

34 WHEREAS, both the VOCA and the SVAA grants have been ongoing annual federal-  
35 pass-through funding awards from the Ohio Office of the Attorney General, and operate during  
36 the Federal Fiscal Year, for the period 10/1/12 through 9/30/13; and

38 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
39 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
40 execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grants from the  
41 Ohio Office of the Attorney General and to appropriate these grant funds through 12/31/12;

43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
44 of Ohio, that:

48 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept  
49 the VOCA award in the amount of \$31,434.00 with a local cash match requirement of \$7,864.00  
50 and an SVAA award in the amount of \$3,286.00 from the Ohio Office of the Attorney General  
51 for the period 10/1/12 through 9/30/13.

30 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
31 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

36 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all

39 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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
