7 **A Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**  
8 **Summit, entitled "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to authorize the Sheriff to hire an external**  
9 **person into the full-time, non-bargaining, unclassified position of Administrative Support-**  
10 **Sheriff, at a salary not to exceed the minimum of \$50,668.80 annually, for the Sheriff, and**  
11 **declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2009-110, which enacted  
14 Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, "Temporary  
15 Hiring Freeze," to control and reduce the County's budget deficit; and

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17 WHEREAS, Section 169.04(j) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that  
18 the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and  
19 continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a resolution authorizing the office to hire  
20 said employee; and

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22 WHEREAS, on September 30, 2012, Bud Darrah will resign, and thereafter, leave a  
23 vacancy in the full-time, non-bargaining, classified position of Assistant Director of  
24 Administration in the County Sheriff's Office; and

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26 WHEREAS, the Sheriff wishes to hire an external person into the full-time, non-  
27 bargaining, unclassified position of Administrative Support-Sheriff, at a salary not to exceed the  
28 minimum of \$50,668.80 annually; and

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30 WHEREAS, there is an available vacancy in the position of Administrative Support-  
31 Sheriff, in the Sheriff's Office pursuant to the Staffing Report for 2012 approved by this Council  
32 through the adoption of Resolution No. 2011-490; and

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34 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
35 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Sheriff to  
36 hire an external person into the full-time, non-bargaining, unclassified position of Administrative  
37 Support-Sheriff, at a salary not to exceed the minimum of \$50,668.80 annually;

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39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,  
40 State of Ohio, that:

42 SECTION 1

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44 County Council hereby determines that the Sheriff has demonstrated that it is necessary  
45 for the effective and continued operation of his office to authorize the Sheriff, pursuant to  
46 Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, to hire an external person  
47 into the full-time, non-bargaining, unclassified position of Administrative Support-Sheriff, at a  
48 salary not to exceed the minimum of \$50,668.80 annually.  
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SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the County Sheriff to hire an external person into the position of Administrative Support-Sheriff in order to continue to effectively operate the Sheriff's Office.

SECTION 3


Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
