7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to enter into a sub-recipient agreement**
8 **with the Summit County Land Reutilization Corporation for the administration of the**
9 **Moving Ohio Forward Grant Program funds and further authorizing the County**
10 **Executive to enter into sub-recipient agreements with the political subdivisions within**
11 **Summit County that will be utilizing said funds, for the Executive's Department of**
12 **Community and Economic Development, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, on behalf of Ohio taxpayer, the Ohio Attorney General has received
15 settlement funds through litigation against certain financial institutions; and

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17 WHEREAS, the Ohio Attorney General has used a portion of those settlement funds to
18 create the Moving Ohio Forward Grant Program to assist communities with demolishing
19 abandoned, vacant and blighted residential properties; and

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21 WHEREAS, the moving Ohio Forward Grant Program is intended to help stabilize the
22 real estate market and declining property values by removing abandoned, vacant and blighted
23 residential structures from our community; and

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25 WHEREAS, under the Moving Ohio Forward Grant Program, the sum of \$3,780,560 has
26 been allocated for use by communities in Summit County, and an additional \$3,280,560 in
27 required matching funds has been raised through commitments from local communities and the
28 Summit County Land Reutilization Corporation ("Summit CLRC"); and

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30 WHEREAS, the Summit CLRC has applied as the lead applicant to receive the Moving
31 Ohio Forward Grant Program funds, and has been awarded said funds; and

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33 WHEREAS, the Summit CLRC will enter into an agreement with the Ohio Attorney
34 General for the receipt and use of the Moving Ohio Forward Grant Program funds; and

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36 WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Summit CLRC to enter into a sub-recipient agreement
37 with the County whereby the County Executive's Department of Community and Economic
38 Development will administer the Moving Ohio Forward Grant Program on behalf of the Summit
39 CLRC; and

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41 WHEREAS, it is further necessary for the Department of Community and Economic
42 Development to enter into sub-recipient agreements with the political subdivisions within
43 Summit County who will be utilizing said funds; and

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45 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
46 that it is necessary and in the best interest of this Council, to authorize the County Executive to
47 enter into a sub-recipient agreement with the Summit CLRC for the administration of the
48 Moving Ohio Forward Grant Program and to further authorize the County Executive to enter into
49 sub-recipient agreements with the political subdivisions within Summit County that will be
50 utilizing said funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into a sub-recipient agreement with the Summit CLRC whereby the Department of Community and Economic Development will administer the Moving Ohio Forward Grant Program on behalf of the Summit CLRC. The County Executive is further authorized to enter into sub-recipient agreements with the political subdivisions within Summit County that will be utilizing said funds.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately authorizing said agreements so that the Moving Ohio Forward Grant Program funds can be spent as quickly as possible.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest possible time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


