## SECTION 23

This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason of immediately repealing certain sections Sections 505.02, 505.23, 505.24, 505.25 and 505.26, amending certain sections, Sections 505.03 through 505.091, 505.13, 505.21, 505.22, 505.52, 505.55, and 505.56 and 505.58 and enacting certain new sections Sections 505.23, 505.24 and 505.99 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit to reflect the changes made to Chapters 955 and Section 1533.71 the Ohio Revised Code by Substitute House Bill 14 and Substitute Senate Bill 310.

## SECTION 34

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## SECTION 45

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
