7 **An amended Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an Ohio Public**
8 **Works Commission grant application and associated documents, with the City of New**
9 **Franklin as lead applicant, for the Route 619/South Turkeyfoot Road Realignment Project**
10 **in the City of New Franklin, Council District 7, at a cost to the County not to exceed**
11 **\$50,000.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the Engineer concludes that there is a public need to realign the intersection
14 of State Route 619 and South Turkeyfoot Road, designated as the Route 619/South Turkeyfoot
15 Road Realignment Project, in the City of New Franklin; and

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17 WHEREAS, the County of Summit is eligible, with and the City of New Franklin as lead
18 applicant, to acquire Ohio Public Works Commission Local Transportation Improvement
19 Program (LTIP) grant funds for the Route 619/South Turkeyfoot Road Realignment Project; and

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21 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
22 necessary and in the best interest of the County to apply for said funds, to authorize the
23 expenditure of up to \$50,000.00 in County local matching road and bridge funds for said
24 improvement and to authorize the County Executive to execute a grant application and
25 associated documents for the Route 619/South Turkeyfoot Road Realignment Project;

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27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
28 of Ohio, that:

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30 SECTION 1

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32 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an Ohio Public Works grant
33 application and other documents necessary for a grant for Ohio Public Works Commission Local
34 Transportation Improvement Program ("LTIP") funds, with the City of New Franklin as lead
35 applicant, for the purpose of realigning and improving the intersection of Route 619 and South
36 Turkeyfoot, designated as the Route 619/South Turkeyfoot Road Realignment Project, in the
37 City of New Franklin, Council District 7.

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39 SECTION 2

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41 The terms of said application shall allocate the cost of the Route 610/South Turkeyfoot
42 Road Realignment Project among the following participants, with the County of Summit's
43 proportional share (Item A) not to exceed \$50,000.00, and with the other participants' shares
44 (Items B and C) covering the remainder of the ~~\$445,000.00~~ \$575,000.00 estimated project cost in
45 amounts approximately equal to the following:

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47 A. County of Summit Road and Bridge Funds	\$	50,000.00
48 B. City of New Franklin	\$	125,000.00
49 C. Ohio Public Works Commission (LTIP)	\$	270,000.00 400,000.00

4 SECTION 3

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6 The expenditure of up to \$50,000.00 in County local matching road and bridge funds as
7 the County of Summit's share of the cost of the project is hereby authorized.

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9 SECTION 4

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11 The County Executive is authorized to execute said grant agreement and other documents
12 necessary to apply for the aforementioned grant funds only for the Ohio Public Works Program
13 Year 27 (2012-2013), with further authorization required for any future grant applications for the
14 Route 619/South Turkeyfoot Road Realignment Project.

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16 SECTION 5

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18 The Clerk of Council is instructed to provide two certified copies of this Resolution to the
19 County Engineer, for submission to the Ohio Public Works Commission with said funding
20 application.

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22 SECTION 6

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24 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
25 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it is necessary to
26 immediately authorize the grant application due to the application deadline of June 30, 2012.

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28 SECTION 7

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30 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight (8) members, it shall take
31 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
32 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


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34 SECTION 8

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36 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
37 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
38 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
39 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
40 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
