A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control for the renewals (2<sup>nd</sup> of 3) of professional service contracts for fiscal year 2013 delinquent care and custody grant police diversion contracts, for the period 7/1/12 through 6/30/13, in a total amount not to exceed \$199,575.00, for the Court of Common Pleas – Juvenile Division, and declaring an emergency.

## SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control for the renewals (second of three) of professional service contracts for fiscal year 2013 delinquent care and custody grant police diversion contracts, as set forth in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully restated, for the period 7/1/12 through 6/30/13, in a total amount not to exceed \$199,575.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such contract renewals.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for fiscal year 2013 delinquent care and custody grant police diversion contract renewals effective 7/1/12.
