7 **A Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**  
8 **Summit, entitled "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to authorize the Executive to hire a full-time**  
9 **unclassified Deputy Director of Property, Casualty and Liability in the Department of Law,**  
10 **Insurance and Risk Management, at the rate of \$34.45 per hour, the midpoint pay rate for**  
11 **the position, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2009-110 and 2011-204, this Council enacted  
14 and extended Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled  
15 "Temporary Hiring Freeze," as a budgetary control measure; and

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17 WHEREAS, Section 169.04(j) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that  
18 the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and  
19 continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a Resolution authorizing the office to hire  
20 said employee; and

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22 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2011-254, which recognized  
23 the consolidation of the County Executive's Department of Law with the Department of  
24 Insurance and Risk Management, including the Executive's plan to transition the existing Deputy  
25 Director of Insurance to a Deputy Director of Property, Casualty and Liability reporting directly  
26 to the Director of the consolidated Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management and  
27 oversee matters pertaining to property and casualty insurance, liability issues and similar matters;

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30 WHEREAS, the person holding the aforementioned Deputy Director position has retired;  
31 and

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33 WHEREAS, the Executive further proposes to hire a full-time unclassified Deputy  
34 Director of Property, Casualty and Liability to replace the retired employee, at the rate of \$34.45  
35 per hour, the midpoint pay rate for the position; and

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37 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
38 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to hire a full-  
39 time unclassified Deputy Director of Property, Casualty and Liability in the Department of Law,  
40 Insurance and Risk Management, at the rate of \$34.45 per hour, the midpoint pay rate for the  
41 position;

43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,  
44 that:

46 SECTION 1

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48 County Council hereby determines that it is necessary for the continued and effective  
49 operation of the County Executive's Office, and further authorizes the Executive to hire a full-  
50 time unclassified Deputy Director of Property, Casualty and Liability at the rate of \$34.45 per  
51 hour, the midpoint pay rate for the position.  
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SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it is necessary to immediately authorize the Executive to hire a full-time unclassified Deputy Director of Property, Casualty and Liability at the rate of \$34.45 per hour, the midpoint pay rate for the position.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121 .22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

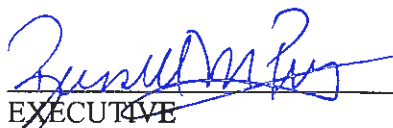
