7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a contract with the Metro**
8 **Regional Transit Authority to purchase three 31-day bus passes to approximately 715**
9 **youth participating in the 2012 Summer Youth Subsidized Employment Program, for a**
10 **total of 2145 bus passes, for the period of 6/1/12 through 8/31/12, in the amount of**
11 **\$107,250.00 in Temporary Assistance for Needy Families funds, for the Executive's**
12 **Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2012-191, which authorizes
15 the County Executive to execute all documents necessary to accept an award from the Ohio
16 Department of Job and Family Services of Temporary Assistance to Needy Family ("TANF")
17 funds, in the amount of \$1,236,917.14. for the operation of a summer youth employment
18 program for TANF-eligible children aged 14-24, and appropriating the same for the period
19 6/1/12 through 12/31/12; and

21 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services wishes to execute a
22 contract with the Metro Regional Transit Authority ("METRO") to purchase three 31-day bus
23 passes for approximately 715 youth participating in the 2012 Summer Youth Subsidized
24 Employment Program, for a total of 2145 bus passes, for the period of 6/1/12 through 8/31/12, in
25 the amount of \$107,250.00 in TANF funds; and

27 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its May 30, 2012 meeting, awarded the
28 aforementioned contract to METRO for the YES Program; and

30 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
31 that the aforementioned contract to METRO is necessary and in the best interest of the County of
32 Summit and the Board of Control's award of the same should be confirmed;

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
35 of Ohio, that:

39 The award by the Board of Control of a contract with the Metro Regional Transit
40 Authority ("METRO") to purchase 2145 three 31-day bus passes for approximately 715 youth
41 participating in the 2012 Summer Youth Subsidized Employment Program, for the period of
42 6/1/12 through 8/31/12, in the amount of \$107,250.00 in Temporary Assistance for Needy
43 Families funds is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute
44 such sub-grant agreement.

49 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
