7 **A Resolution declaring it necessary to renew an existing tax levy of 2.25 mills for the**  
8 **operation of the Summit County Children Services Board, established under Ohio Revised**  
9 **Code Chapter 5153, to support children services and the care and placement of children,**  
10 **and requesting the County Fiscal Officer to certify to the taxing authority the total current**  
11 **tax valuation of the County and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by**  
12 **that renewal levy, for the Children Services Board, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Council of the County of Summit (the Council) is the taxing authority of  
15 the County pursuant to Article III, Section 3.01 of the County Charter; and

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17 WHEREAS, the electors of this County on November 6, 2007 approved the replacement  
18 with a reduction of a 2.56 mill levy, being a reduction of 0.31 mills, to constitute a tax levy of 2.25  
19 mills for the operation of the Summit County Children Services Board established under Ohio  
20 Revised Code Chapter 5153 to support children services and the care and placement of children;  
21 and

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23 WHEREAS, the authority to levy the aforesaid tax expires with the levy heretofore made  
24 on the 2012 tax duplicate for distribution to the County in 2013; and

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26 WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will  
27 be insufficient to provide for the aforesaid purpose, and it is necessary to renew the 2.25 mill tax  
28 levy, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.19, 5705.191 and 5705.24; and

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30 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Social Services Advisory Board has recommended  
31 that the Council place upon the ballot at the election on November 6, 2012 the question of the  
32 renewal of the existing tax levy, being a tax levy of 2.25 mills for the aforesaid purpose, to run  
33 for a period of six (6) years, beginning with the 2013 tax list and duplicate, for collection in the  
34 years 2014 through 2019, inclusive; and

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36 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5705.03(B) of the Ohio Revised Code, it is necessary  
37 for the taxing authority to certify to the County Fiscal Officer a resolution requesting that the  
38 County Fiscal Officer certify to the taxing authority the total current tax valuation of the County,  
39 and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the aforesaid renewal levy; and

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41 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
42 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to declare the necessity of  
43 renewing the aforementioned tax levy of 2.25 mills for the Summit County Children Services  
44 Board and to certify this Resolution to the Fiscal Officer requesting that she certify to the taxing  
45 authority the total current tax valuation of the County, and the dollar amount of revenue that  
46 would be generated by the aforesaid renewal levy; and

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48 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,  
49 State of Ohio, two-thirds of all the members elected thereto concurring, that:

4 SECTION 1

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6 It is necessary to renew the existing 2.25 mill tax levy, in excess of the ten-mill  
7 limitation, to constitute a 2.25 mill tax levy for a period of six (6) years commencing with the tax  
8 duplicate of 2013 for collection in the years 2014 through 2019, inclusive, for the operation of  
9 the Summit County Children Services Board, established under Ohio Revised Code Chapter  
10 5153, to support children services and the care and placement of children, and that it is necessary  
11 to submit the question of the renewal of that levy to the electors at an election on November 6,  
12 2012, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.19, 5705.191 and 5705.24.

13  
14 SECTION 2

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16 In accordance with Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, this Council authorizes  
17 and requests the Clerk of Council to certify a copy of this resolution to the County Fiscal Officer  
18 for calculation of the total current tax valuation of the County and for calculation of the dollar  
19 amount of revenue that would be generated by the aforesaid renewal levy of 2.25 mills. This  
20 Council requests the County Fiscal Officer to thereupon certify to it both (i) the total current tax  
21 valuation of the County, and (ii) the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the  
22 aforesaid renewal levy of 2.25 mills.

24 SECTION 3

25  
26 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
27 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to timely certify to the  
28 Board of Elections this ballot issue.

29  
30 SECTION 4

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32 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
33 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
34 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

35  
36 SECTION 5

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38 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
39 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
40 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were  
41 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
42 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
