7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of various professional service**
8 **contract renewals (second and final), per attached Exhibit A, for Workforce Investment**
9 **Act non-violent former felon services, for the period 7/1/12 through 6/30/13, in a total**
10 **amount not to exceed \$320,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family**
11 **Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 9, 2012, awarded various
14 professional service contract renewals (second and final), per attached Exhibit A, for Workforce
15 Investment Act non-violent former felon services, for the period 7/1/12 through 6/30/13, subject
16 to confirmation by County Council; and,

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18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
19 that the contract renewals are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
22 of Ohio, that:

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26 The award by the Board of Control of various professional service contract renewals
27 (second and final), per attached Exhibit A, for Workforce Investment Act non-violent former
28 felon services, for the period 7/1/12 through 6/30/13, in a total amount not to exceed
29 \$320,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such
30 contract renewals.


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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
