7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with**
8 **Motorola, Inc., for five portable radios and related equipment for the Youngstown Bomb**
9 **Squad, under State Term Pricing, in an amount not to exceed \$27,263.00, for the**
10 **Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management – Division of Public**
11 **Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 9, 2012, awarded a purchase
14 order with Motorola, Inc., for five portable radios and related equipment for the Youngstown
15 Bomb Squad, under State Term Pricing, subject to confirmation by County Council; and,

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17 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
18 that the purchase order is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
21 of Ohio, that:

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23 SECTION 1

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25 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with Motorola, Inc., for five
26 portable radios and related equipment for the Youngstown Bomb Squad, under State Term
27 Pricing, in an amount not to exceed \$27,263.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is
28 hereby authorized to execute such purchase order.

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30 SECTION 2

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32 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
33 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
34 provide radios and related equipment.

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36 SECTION 3

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38 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
39 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
40 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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42 SECTION 4

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44 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
45 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
46 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
47 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
48 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
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
