7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute all documents necessary to**
8 **accept an award from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services of Temporary**
9 **Assistance to Needy Family funds in the amount of \$1,236,917.14 for the operation of a**
10 **summer youth employment program for TANF-eligible children aged 14-24, and**
11 **appropriating the same for the period 6/1/12 through 12/31/12, for the Executive's**
12 **Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("County
15 DJFS") has received notice of an allocation from the Ohio Department of Job and Family
16 Services ("Ohio DJFS") of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families ("TANF") funds in the
17 amount of \$1,236,917.14 for a summer youth employment program; and

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19 WHEREAS, the aforementioned allocation has been provided to the County in order to
20 fund a summer employment program for certain TANF-eligible Summit County youth aged 14-
21 24; and

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23 WHEREAS, the County DJFS desires to institute a program using the aforementioned
24 allocation whereby certain TANF-eligible youth meeting certain requirements will be employed
25 during the period 6/11/12 through 8/31/12; and

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27 WHEREAS, the County DJFS intends to contract directly with several employers
28 whereby those employers will hire the TANF-eligible youth and the County will then reimburse
29 the employers for the wages and benefits paid to the youth employees; and

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31 WHEREAS, the County further intends to enter into an intergovernmental agreement or
32 memorandum of understanding with the County Executive's Youth Employment for Success
33 ("YES") program whereby YES will assist the County DJFS with the administration of the
34 aforementioned project and will directly employ certain TANF-eligible youth for use by several
35 small employers and certain public entities; and

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37 WHEREAS, this Council hereby finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent
38 information, that the operation of the aforementioned program to provide summer employment
39 for certain TANF-eligible youth is necessary and in the best interest of this Council, and further
40 authorizes the County Executive to execute all documents necessary to accept the
41 aforementioned funds and further appropriates the same for the period 6/1/12 through 12/31/12.

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43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
44 State of Ohio, that:

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48 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to accept
49 the award from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services ("Ohio DJFS") of Temporary
50 Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") funds in the amount of \$1,236,917.14 for the operation
51 of a summer youth employment program for TANF-eligible children aged 14-24.

29 effect and be in force at the earliest possible time provided by law.


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31 SECTION 6


