A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept a 2012 Continuation Grant from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Child Support Enforcement, for the period 1/1/13 through 8/31/13, in the amount of \$50,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating the total amount of \$50,000.00 for expenditures in 2013, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Child Support Enforcement ("OCSE") has awarded a 2012 Continuation Grant to the County of Summit Prosecutor's Office, for the period 1/1/13 through 8/31/13, in the amount of \$50,000.00, for salaries and benefit expenses, with no local cash match requirement; and

WHEREAS, this special improvement program grant provides funding for an outreach coordinator to run the diversion program with the County of Summit Domestic Relations Court, in partnership with workforce development, local fatherhood initiatives, and the University of Akron, to demonstrate that coordinated services that support the entire family can improve the likelihood that support payments will be made; and

WHEREAS, this award is supplemental funding for the current OCSE funding and extends the grant period to 8/31/13; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the Federal Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Child Support Enforcement, and to appropriate the total amount of \$50,000.00 for expenditures in 2013;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of a 2012 Continuation Grant from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Child Support Enforcement ("OCSE"), for the period 1/1/13 through 8/31/13, in the amount of \$50,000.00 with no local cash match requirement.
