7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for a five-year full**  
8 **maintenance service agreement for twelve elevators at six county-maintained buildings per**  
9 **attached Exhibit A, in Council Districts 2 and 4, for an estimated total cost not to exceed**  
10 **\$216,500.00, for the Executive's Department of Administrative Services – Physical Plants,**  
11 **and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit  
14 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

15  
16 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for a five-year full  
17 maintenance service agreement for twelve elevators at six county-maintained buildings per  
18 attached Exhibit A, in Council Districts 2 and 4; and

20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
21 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
22 advertise for bids for the aforementioned project;

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
25 of Ohio, that;

27 SECTION 1

29 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for a five-year full maintenance  
30 service agreement for twelve elevators at six county-maintained buildings per attached Exhibit  
31 A, in Council Districts 2 and 4, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$216,500.00.

33 SECTION 2

35 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare  
36 of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the  
37 Executive to immediately advertise for bids to replace the current agreement which will expire  
38 6/30/13.

40 SECTION 3

42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

46 SECTION 4

48 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
49 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
50 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were  
51 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
52 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
