7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept the award of a Justice Assistance Grant Victim Advocacy Grant from the Ohio**
9 **Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services, in the amount of**
10 **\$25,000.00, with a 25% local cash match requirement, in the amount of \$8,333.32, and a**
11 **supplemental cash match amount of \$5,407.00 required for certain employment**
12 **expenditures not covered by the grant, for the period 1/1/13 through 12/31/13, and**
13 **appropriating the amount of \$38,740.32, which includes the total local cash match**
14 **requirement, for calendar year 2013, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, the Ohio Office of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services, has
17 awarded a Justice Assistance Grant ("JAG") Victim Advocacy Grant of federal funds, in the
18 amount of \$25,000.00, with a 25% local cash match requirement, in the amount of \$8,333.32, for
19 the period 1/1/13 through 12/31/13; and

21 WHEREAS, an additional local cash match of \$5,407.00, for a total match of \$13,740.32,
22 is needed to cover the program's additional personnel costs, including that of the employee's
23 hospital waiver and life insurance as these items are not covered under the grant guidelines; and

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25 WHEREAS, the match funds are appropriated in the Prosecutor's 2013 operating budget,
26 which was approved by Resolution No. 2012-475; and

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28 WHEREAS, this annual funding supports a victim advocate position in order to provide
29 the mandated services to victims of crime; and

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31 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
32 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
33 execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the Ohio
34 Office of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services, and to appropriate said grant funds;

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36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
37 of Ohio, that:

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41 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept
42 the Justice Assistance Grant ("JAG") award from the Ohio Office of Public Safety, Office of
43 Criminal Justice Services, in the amount of \$25,000.00, with a 25% local cash match
44 requirement, in the amount of \$8,333.32, and a supplemental cash match amount of \$5,407.00
45 required for additional personnel costs including certain employment expenditures not covered
46 by the grant, for the period 1/1/13 through 12/31/13, for a total amount of \$38,740.32.

34 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
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
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


