A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with D&G Uniforms for the uniform allowance for Sheriff's deputies and supervisors, per Article 27 of the bargaining agreement, as Best Practical Source, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with D&G Uniforms for the uniform allowance for Sheriff's deputies and supervisors, per Article 27 of the bargaining agreement, as Best Practical Source, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase order.

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
