An <u>amended Ordinance</u> amending Chapter 201 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Consumer Affairs Board," to be renamed "Office of Consumer Affairs," and amending other certain sections consistent with said amendment to Chapter 201, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, in 2004, this Council enacted Chapter 201 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Consumer Affairs Board," thereby creating a Consumer Affairs Board and Office of Consumer Affairs that reported to said Board; and

WHEREAS, the Consumer Affairs Board and Office of Consumer Affairs primarily promote the enforcement of laws and enforce laws relating to unfair, deceptive and unconscionable consumer sales practices and the education of the public about such practices; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has proposed amending Chapter 201 to eliminate the Consumer Affairs Board and to consolidate the Office of Consumer Affairs into the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management on the basis of operational efficiency and due to the legal nature of much of the business of the Office of Consumer Affairs; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to amend Chapter 201 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit as proposed by the Executive;

SECTION 3

The County Executive's Department of Human Resources is hereby authorized to make any necessary amendments and/or modifications to the County's Classification and Compensation Plan, associated position descriptions, and the current Report on Staffing provided that said authority does not extend to modifying the rates of compensation set forth in the Classification and Compensation Plan.
