7 **A Resolution supporting the introduction of a bill by State Representative Anthony DeVitis**
8 **to extend the portion of State Route 619 named the "Sgt. 1st Class Daniel B. Crabtree**
9 **Memorial Road" into Summit County from the eastern County line to the intersection of**
10 **State Route 93 through the Cities of Green and New Franklin, in Council Districts 7 and 8,**
11 **for Council, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, Army Sgt. 1st Class Daniel B. Crabtree gave his life for his country on June
14 6, 2006 during combat operations in Operation Iraqi Freedom; and

15
16 WHEREAS, former State Representative Todd Snitchler sponsored House Bill 23 in the
17 129th General Assembly which enacted Section 5533.636 of the Ohio Revised Code to honor
18 Sgt. Crabtree by naming the portion of State Route 619 located in the City of Hartville in Stark
19 County the "Sgt. 1st Class Daniel B. Crabtree Memorial Road;" and

21 WHEREAS, residents in the City of Green, in Council District 8, have requested that
22 Representative Anthony DeVitis introduce a bill amending Section 5533.636 to extend the
23 portion of State Route 619 named the "Sgt. 1st Class Daniel B. Crabtree Memorial Road" into
24 Summit County from the eastern County line to the intersection of State Route 93 through the
25 Cities of Green and New Franklin, in Council Districts 7 and 8; and

27 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information
28 that it is necessary, and in the best interest of the County of Summit, to declare that Council
29 supports the introduction of a bill by State Representative DeVitis to extend the portion of State
30 Route 619 named the "Sgt. 1st Class Daniel B. Crabtree Memorial Road" into Summit County
31 from the eastern County line to the intersection of State Route 93 through the Cities of Green and
32 New Franklin;

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,

39 This Council hereby supports the introduction of a bill by State Representative Anthony
40 DeVitis to extend the portion of State Route 619 named the "Sgt. 1st Class Daniel B. Crabtree

42 Route 93 through the Cities of Green and New Franklin, in Council Districts 7 and 8.

46 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
47 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
48 support the introduction of a bill honoring Sgt. 1st Class Daniel B. Crabtree by extending that
49 portion of State Route 619 named for him into Summit County from the eastern County line to
50 the intersection of State Route 93 through the Cities of Green and New Franklin.

17 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


