10 **not to exceed \$215,000.00, for FICA Workers Compensation and administrative fees, for**
11 **the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
14 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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16 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for a vendor to act as the
17 employer of record and provide payroll services for the 2013 Summer Youth Employment
18 Program, for the period 5/15/13 through 8/31/13; and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
21 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
22 advertise for bids for the aforementioned services;

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24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
25 of Ohio, that;

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27 SECTION 1

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29 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for a vendor to act as the
30 employer of record and provide payroll services for the 2013 Summer Youth Employment
31 Program, for the period 5/15/13 through 8/31/13, for an estimated total cost not to exceed
32 \$215,000.00, for FICA Workers Compensation and administration fees.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
37 of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
38 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for payroll services for the 2013 Summer Youth
39 Employment Program in 2013.

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41 SECTION 3

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
