A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to establish the intersection of Riverview Road and Boston Mills Road in Boston Township, in Council District 1, a four-way stop intersection for the period 5/18/13 through 5/26/13, and thereafter reverting to a two-way stop intersection, with the stop signs installed for the eastbound and westbound Boston Mills Road traffic, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Section 5553.02 of the Ohio Revised Code grants authority to locate, alter, or vacate roads to the board of county commissioners, and

WHEREAS, Section 5553.04 of the Ohio Revised Code establishes the procedure for establishing, altering, or vacating roads, and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad desires to celebrate "Thomas the Tank Engine" event, and has asked the County Engineer to assist in traffic control by establishing a four-way stop at the intersection of Riverview Road and Boston Mills Road, in Boston Township, in Council District 1, due to the increased vehicular and pedestrian traffic anticipated during the time of this event; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the County Executive to establish said four-way stop intersection for the period 5/18/13 through 5/26/13, when the "Thomas the Tank Engine" event takes place; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to establish a four-way stop at the intersection of Riverview Road and Boston Mills Road in Boston Township for the period 5/18/13 through 5/26/13 for the aforementioned reason;
