A Resolution approving the issuance by the County of Franklin, Ohio, of Health Care Facilities Refunding and Improvement Revenue Bonds (OPRS Communities) in one or more series, and authorizing the County Executive and County Fiscal Officer to execute all documents and take all actions necessary and appropriate to effectuate the issuance of the Bonds, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County of Summit, Ohio, has entered into a Public Hospital Agencies Agreement ("Agreement") with the County of Franklin, Ohio, the County of Shelby, Ohio, the County of Butler, Ohio, the County of Mahoning, Ohio, the County of Lucas, Ohio, the County of Hamilton, Ohio, the County of Clinton, Ohio, the County of Trumbull, Ohio, the County of Ottawa, Ohio, and the City of Willoughby, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement, the County of Franklin, Ohio, intends to issue Health Care Facilities Refunding and Improvement Revenue Bonds (OPRS Communities) in one or more series ("Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, a portion of the Bonds will used to finance and/or refinance facilities of the Rockynol Retirement Community ("Project"), which is located in the County of Summit in Council District 3; and

WHEREAS, to comply with Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended ("Code"), a public hearing is needed in the County of Summit, Ohio, and, thereafter, the County of Summit, Ohio, must approve of the Bonds to be issued by Franklin County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Code, the County of Summit Council is the applicable elected representative authorized to approve the Bonds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The Planning and Economic Development Committee of the County of Summit Council has held a public hearing on September 23, 2013, at 4:30 p.m. in Council Chambers. The public was invited to make comments at said hearing and notice of such hearing with respect to the approval of the Bonds was published in *The Akron Beacon Journal* on or before September 9, 2013.

SECTION 2

This Council hereby approves the issuance of the Bonds. It is anticipated that the proceeds of the Bonds will be used to finance the Project and that the balance of the proceeds of the Bonds will be used to fund health care facilities throughout the State of Ohio. This approval is intended to comply solely with the Code and does not constitute a finding by the County or this Council that Franklin County, Ohio, or Ohio Presbyterian Retirement Services, Inc., or any other party are in compliance with the legal requirements imposed upon them in connection with the issuance of the Bonds.

SECTION 3

The County Executive, the Fiscal Officer, and the Clerk of County Council are each separately authorized to take any and all actions and to execute such financing statements, assignments, certificates and other instruments that may be necessary or appropriate, in the opinion of Ice Miller, LLP, as Bond Counsel, in order to effect the issuance of the Bonds, the financing of the Project and the intent of this Resolution.

SECTION 4

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the County, and for the further reason that this Resolution is required to be immediately effective in order to authorize the Bonds as soon as practicable.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
