A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a renewal of a cooperative agreement with the City of Akron for an additional term of five years, whereby the County and Akron share the County's office services facilities, share the expenses of equipment and combine purchase of supplies, for the Executive's Department of Finance and Budget, and declaring an emergency.
WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2008-468, this Council authorized the County Executive to execute a cooperative agreement with the City of Akron to share the County's office services facilities, share the expenses of equipment and combined purchase of supplies for the period of five years, with a renewal term of five years; and
WHEREAS, the County and City of Akron desire to renew said agreement for an additional five-year period; and
WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to enter into a cooperative agreement with the City of Akron whereby the County and the City of Akron shall share the expenses of equipment, facilities and combining their purchase of supplies for Office Services;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into a renewal of a cooperative agreement with the City of Akron whereby the County and the City of Akron share the expenses of equipment, facilities and combine their purchase of supplies for Office Services.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it will immediately authorize the County Executive to execute said renewal to the cooperative agreement and continue to realize substantial cost savings for the County.

SECTION 3

Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
