A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of federal funds from the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office of a Federal Fiscal Year 2014 Victims of Crime Act grant, in the amount of \$62,941.00, with a local cash match requirement of \$20,980.00, and a State Victims Assistance Act grant in the amount of \$3,470.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 10/1/13 through 9/30/14, and appropriating \$87,391.00 for expenditures through 12/31/13, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Prosecutor's Office has received an award from the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office of a Federal Fiscal Year 2014 Victims of Crime Act ("VOCA") grant in the amount of \$62,941.00, which has a 25% local cash match requirement of \$20,980.00, for a VOCA award total of \$83,921.00, for the period 10/1/13 through 9/30/14; and

WHEREAS, the Prosecutor's Office has received an award from the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office of a Federal Fiscal Year 2014 State Victims Assistance Act ("SVAA") grant in the amount of \$3,470.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 10/1/13 through 9/30/14, and for which the Ohio Attorney General's Office requires an accounting identity separate from the VOCA award; and

WHEREAS, the VOCA and SVAA are annual grants which help to support salary and benefits for a Victim Advocate and a Victim Services Coordinator, both full-time staff providing advocacy services to crime victims in Summit County; and

WHEREAS, the Prosecutor's Office provides for the required VOCA grant match within their annual budget; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grants from the State of Ohio Attorney General's Office, and to appropriate these grant funds;
