WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information that the aforementioned intergovernmental agreement with the City of Akron is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1
