A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a lease with Bath Township for salt storage facilities at 3879 Ira Road, Akron, Ohio 44333, for a one-year term, from 11/1/16 to 10/31/17, in an amount not to exceed \$7,200.00, with four options to renew for an additional one-year term, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 7, 2016, awarded a lease with Bath Township for salt storage facilities at 3879 Ira Road, Akron, Ohio 44333, in Council District 1, for a one-year term, from 11/1/16 through 10/31/17, in an amount not to exceed \$7,200.00, with four options to renew for an additional one-year term, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned lease with Bath Township is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a lease with Bath Township for salt storage facilities at 3879 Ira Road, Akron, Ohio 44333, in Council District 1, for a one-year term, from 11/1/16 through 10/31/17, in amount not to exceed \$7,200.00, with four options to renew for an additional one-year term, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute said lease agreement.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide a necessary lease renewal to store salt in Bath Township for the current snow and ice control season due to the Engineer not having another storage location in that part of the County.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
