A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a renewal (first of two) of a professional service contract with The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work to provide Employee Assistance Program services, for the period 1/1/17 to 12/31/17, for a total amount not to exceed \$138,000.00, and authorizing said services to also be provided to employees of political subdivisions that have executed an Employee Assistance Program Participation Agreement with the County, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held October 12, 2016, awarded a renewal (first of two) of a professional service contract with The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work for Employee Assistance Program ("EAP") services for County employees for the period 1/1/17 through 12/31/17, for an amount not to exceed \$15.30 per employee per year, for a total amount not to exceed \$138,000.00, and authorized said EAP services under the professional service contract with The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work to also be provided to employees of political subdivisions that have executed an Employee Assistance Program Participation Agreement with the County, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, in addition to confirming the award by the Board of Control of the aforementioned professional service contract, it is further necessary for this Council to authorize that the EAP services provided to County employees pursuant to the aforementioned professional service contract with The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work shall also be provided to employees of political subdivisions that have executed an Employee Assistance Program Participation Agreement with the County; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned professional service contract with The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work to provide EAP services is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit and it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize said EAP services to also be provided to employees of political subdivisions that have executed an Employee Assistance Program Participation Agreement with the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

#### SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (first of two) of a professional service contract with The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work for Employee Assistance Program ("EAP) services for County employees and employees of other participating political subdivisions, for the period 1/1/17 through 12/31/17, for an amount not to exceed \$15.30 per employee per year, for a total amount not to exceed \$138,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such renewal of said professional service contract.

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## **SECTION 2**

This Council hereby authorizes EAP services provided to County employees pursuant to the aforementioned professional service contract with The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work to also be provided to employees of political subdivisions that have executed an Employee Assistance Program Participation Agreement with the County.

# **SECTION 3**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately approve a necessary contract to provide EAP services to County employees and to immediately authorize said EAP services to also be provided to employees of political subdivisions that have executed an Employee Assistance Program Participation Agreement with the County effective 1/1/17.

### **SECTION 4**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

### **SECTION 5**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
