A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a Local Public Agency Agreement with the State of Ohio Department of Transportation for two traffic studies, for an estimated cost not to exceed \$24,000.00, with a 10% local cash match requirement of \$2,400.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration has approved funding for traffic safety studies for the South Main Street/Killian Road intersection in Coventry Township and for the Valley View Road/North Boyden Road/Acadia Drive intersection in Sagamore Hills Township, in Council Districts 1 and 8, Project Identification ("PID") No. 103470 (the "Study"); and

WHEREAS, the Study's estimated cost is \$24,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration funds have been awarded to the County Engineer's office for a grant to cover 90% of the Study with a 10% local cash match requirement of \$2,400.00, to be paid from the Motor Vehicle Gas Tax Fund; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") and the Engineer desire to enter into a Local Public Agency ("LPA") Agreement to confirm the Study's Cost and to designate the County of Summit as the lead agency for administration of the Study; and

WHEREAS, Sections 5501.03(A)(3) and 5543.01 of the Ohio Revised Code and Article II, Section 2.03(5) of the County of Summit Charter allow the execution of such agreements, subject to the approval of this Council; and

WHEREAS, said LPA Agreement will state that ODOT shall provide \$21,600.00 in eligible costs from Federal Highway Administration funds for the Study; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned LPA Agreement with ODOT;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

DECOLUTION NO

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Local Public Agency ("LPA") Agreement with the State of Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") for traffic safety studies for the South Main Street/Killian Road intersection in Coventry Township and for the Valley View Road/North Boyden Road/Acadia Drive intersection in Sagamore Hills Township, in Council Districts 1 and 8, Project Identification ("PID") No. 103470 (the "Study"), for an estimated cost not to exceed \$24,000.00, with a 10% local cash match requirement of \$2,400.00, to be paid from the Motor Vehicle Gas Tax Fund.

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SECTION 2

The terms of said LPA Agreement shall include the following:

- a. That the parties estimate the Study's Cost to be \$24,000.00;
- b. That ODOT hall provide \$21,600.00 in Federal Safety funds, with a 10% local cash match requirement of \$2,400.00, to be paid from the Motor Vehicle Gas Tax Fund;
- c. That the County of Summit shall provide all other financial resources necessary to fully complete the Study; and
- d. That, upon receipt of federal authorization from ODOT, the County may commence the administration of the Study, with award of the Study subject to applicable County of Summit Ordinances, said ordinances requiring authorization of such an award by the Board of Control.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately authorizes the Executive to execute the LPA Agreement with ODOT for the Study to provide safe and convenient travel within Summit County.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
