	WHEREAS, the County Engineer has concluded there is a public need to replace the existing Vanderhoof Road Bridge over the Tuscarawas River (FRA-215-0290), located in the City of New Franklin, in Council District 7; and			
	WHEREAS, parcels of real property and temporary easements of right-of-way are needed for the Vanderhoof Road Bridge Replacement Project (herein the "Project"); and			
	WHEREAS, the County of Summit and Butcher C & D LLC are unable to agree upon the purchase price of said parcels of real property or temporary easements of right-of-way on parcet of real property owned by Butcher C & D LLC; and			
WHEREAS, it is necessary to acquire said parcels of real property as easements of right-of-way by court proceedings under the provisions of Section Chapter 163 of the Ohio Revised Code; and				
	WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to proceed with said appropriation proceedings for the aforementioned reason;			
	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;			
	SECTION 1			
	The County of Summit hereby declares its intention to appropriate parcels of real property and temporary easements of right-of-way for highway purposes on parcels of real property as described by Exhibit A, attached hereto, said purposes to include the replacement of the Vanderhoof Road Bridge over the Tuscarawas River, said property being owned by Butcher C & D LLC (herein the "Owners"), located in the City of New Franklin, Council District 7.			
	SECTION 2			

The County Prosecutor is hereby directed to prepare and file on behalf of the County of

Summit, Ohio, proceedings for appropriation under the provisions of Chapter 163 of the Ohio Revised Code of said parcels of real property and temporary easements of right-of-way on

parcels of real property described by Exhibit A.

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SECTION 3	

The County Engineer, through the County Fiscal Officer, is hereby authorized to drawn by voucher upon the County of Summit and pay into the Court of Common Pleas-Probate Division at the time of the filing of a complaint for the appropriation of said parcels of real property and temporary easements of right-of-way on parcels of real property, under the provisions of Chapter 163 of the Ohio Revised Code, a sum not to exceed \$495.00.

SECTION 4

This Resolution shall be published in accordance with Section 121.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit.

SECTION 5

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Summit County, and for the further reason that it will immediately allow commencement of appropriation proceedings related to an improvement to the County's highway system.

SECTION 6

Provided this resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight (8) members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 7

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
