A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of a Safety and Justice Challenge Grant from the MacArthur Foundation, for the period 1/1/17 through 6/30/18, in the amount of \$50,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating these grant funds, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management – Division of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management – Division of Public Safety has been awarded a Safety and Justice Challenge Grant from the MacArthur Foundation, for the period 1/1/17 through 6/30/18, in the amount of \$50,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, to design and test innovative local justice reforms to safely drive down jail usage and reduce racial and ethnic disparities in their local justice systems; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Public Safety, the County Sheriff and City of Akron have agreed to participate as partner agencies in this program in order to develop a felony summons initiative which will divert low level, non-violent felony offenders who would otherwise be eligible for a personal recognizance bond, from being housed in the County jail; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned Safety and Justice Challenge Grant, and to appropriate these grant funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
