**Summit County Engineer's Recommendation
Canfield Road
Request to Vacate a Portion of Township Road**

Background: By copy of an email dated March 3, 2017 the Summit County Engineer's office was formally notified by Chief of Staff Mark Potter, MPA that Resolution 2017-098 would be introduced to County Council seeking the vacation of a portion of Canfield Road. For several months, the County Engineer's staff had been aware that an action similar to this was being considered by Springfield Township and we have worked with their local surveying firm of Gary L. Phillips and Associates to accommodate the township's desire.

The email and the resolution establish a date for the Council to conduct a public hearing on the vacation of the portion of Canfield Road, (Monday, March 27, 2017 at 4:30 p.m.). A public viewing for the vacation has not been scheduled. The resolution also stated that the "

"The County Engineer shall submit a written report on the vacation and proposed dedication containing the Engineer's opinion for or against the vacation and for or against the proposed dedication and shall do so on or before March 13, 2017."

Issue: A portion of Canfield Road was relocated in 2001, the new alignment was not dedicated, and the former alignment was not vacated at that time. This proposed action will correct that oversight.

Canfield Road is an east west facility, approximately 1.02 miles in length and roughly parallels the northern edge of Springfield Lake in Springfield Township. The portion of Canfield Road relocated in 2001 extends from approximately 75 west of the intersection at Kubler Avenue and continues eastward for a distance of approximately 1050 feet. Prior to the 2001 relocation, Canfield Road followed an alignment now occupied by the parking lot of the Springfield Township's Administration building.

Attached are three aerial photographs from the Summit County GIS website showing:

- Conditions in 2000 – prior to the relocation,
- Conditions in 2005 – after the relocation, and
- Conditions in 2015 – the most recent photography on the website.

Recommendation: The Summit County Engineer recommends for the vacation and the dedication of the portion of Canfield Road relocated in 2001 and depicted on the Exhibit "B" referenced in Resolution 2017-089.
