7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **Blue Technologies Smart Solutions, for OnBase Modules and software maintenance and**
9 **support, in an amount not to exceed \$72,701.21, at GSA Pricing, for the Office of**
10 **Information Technology, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held March 15, 2017, awarded a
13 purchase contract to Blue Technologies Smart Solutions, to OnBase Modules and software
14 maintenance and support, in an amount not to exceed \$72,701.21, at GSA Pricing, approved by
15 the IT Board on 3/2/17, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

17 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
18 the aforementioned purchase contract with Blue Technologies Smart Solutions is necessary and
19 in the best interest of the County of Summit;

21 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
22 of Ohio, that:

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24 SECTION 1

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26 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Blue Technologies Smart
27 Solutions, to provide OnBase Modules and software maintenance and support, approved by the
28 IT Board on 3/2/17 in an amount not to exceed \$71,701.21, at GSA Pricing, is hereby confirmed
29 and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute said contract.

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31 SECTION 2

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33 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
34 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
35 provide certain County offices with the necessary OnBase Modules and software maintenance
36 and support.

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38 SECTION 3

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40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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44 SECTION 4

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46 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
47 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
48 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
49 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
50 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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


