15 Youth Employment Program ("SYEP") Monitoring Services Agreements with certain providers,
16 per the attached Exhibit A, for monitoring services, work readiness skills training and other
17 additional services, for the period of 5/1/17 through 9/30/17, in a total amount not to exceed
18 \$270,000.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

30 Monitoring Services Agreements with certain providers, per attached Exhibit A, for monitoring
31 services, work readiness skills training and other additional services, for the period 5/1/17
32 through 9/30/17, in a total amount not to exceed \$270,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the
33 County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such agreements.

37 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
38 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
39 provide for SYEP monitoring services, work readiness skills training and other additional
