A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to establish the intersection of Riverview Road and Boston Mills Road in Boston Township as a four-way stop intersection for the period of 5/12/17 through 5/30/17, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 5553.02 of the Ohio Revised Code grants authority to locate, alter, or vacate roads to boards of county commissioners; and

WHEREAS, Section 5553.04 of the Ohio Revised Code establishes the procedure for establishing, altering or vacating roads; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad desires to celebrate the "Day Out With Thomas" event, and has asked the County Engineer to assist in traffic control by establishing a four-way stop at the intersection at Riverview Road and Boston Mills Road, in Boston Township, in Council District 1, for the period of 5/12/17 through 5/30/17, due to the increased vehicular and pedestrian traffic anticipated during the time of this event;

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to establish the aforementioned temporary four-way stop intersection in Boston Township, for the period of 5/12/17 through 5/30/17, for the aforementioned reason;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION I

The County Executive is hereby authorized to establish the intersection of Riverview Road and Boston Mills Road as a temporary four-way stop intersection for the period of 5/12/17 through 5/30/17, after which said intersection shall revert to a two-way stop intersection with the stop signs installed for the eastbound and westbound Boston Mills Road traffic. The County Engineer is hereby authorized to take any actions necessary in conjunction with the Executive to establish said four-way stop intersection.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately ensures safe travel for pedestrians and workers for the "Day Out With Thomas" event for the period of 5/12/17 through 5/30/17.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
