A Resolution approving the award by the Summit County Board of Elections of a contract to Tenex Software Solutions, Inc. for the purchase through Ohio's electronic poll book purchasing program of the Tenex electronic poll book system including 770 E-Poll Books for the Board of Elections, for an amount not to exceed \$1,046,700.00, authorizing said purchase, and appropriating funds, in the amount of \$1,281,750.00, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2017-024, which authorized the County Executive to execute a memorandum of understanding with the Ohio Department of Administrative Services ("DAS") and the Summit County Board of Elections concerning the purchase of selected electronic poll books and any other necessary equipment, for which the Department will reimburse the County for 85% of the cost; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit 1 to the memorandum of understanding, which is attached to Resolution No. 2017-024 as Exhibit A, sets forth an allocation of \$593,774.39 for Summit County for reimbursement of electronic pollbooks and any other necessary equipment for which the deadline to request reimbursement from DAS is May 31, 2017; and
