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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive execute any documents and take whatever**
8 **other action is necessary to notify the Ohio Board of Building Standards and any other**
9 **necessary State agencies that the County of Summit relinquishes its certification to enforce**
10 **and inspect medical gas systems, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 4101:1 of the Ohio Administrative Code, a county
13 building department may enforce the medical gas systems provisions of the Ohio Building Code,
14 Ohio Mechanical Code and Ohio Plumbing Code, provided that it employs the requisite medical
15 gas systems inspectors and applies for and obtains the certification of the Ohio Board of Building
16 Standards, which certification the County of Summit completed in 2010; and

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18 WHEREAS, the County Executive has determined it is no longer in the best interest of
19 the County of Summit to continue to engage in these inspections and therefore wishes to
20 relinquish the County's certification to the Ohio Board of Building Standards to enforce and
21 inspect medical gas systems; and

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23 WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4101:1, if a County elects
24 not to continue to keep current the certification, the enforcement of medical gas inspections will
25 be performed by the Ohio Division of Industrial Compliance; and

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27 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
28 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
29 execute any documents and take whatever other action is necessary to notify the Ohio Board of
30 Building Standards and any other necessary State agencies that the County of Summit
31 relinquishes its certification to enforce and inspect medical gas systems;

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33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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6 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
7 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
8 relinquish the County's certification to enforce and inspect medical gas systems in order for the
9 Ohio Division of Industrial Compliance to immediately enforce and inspect said medical gas
10 systems in Summit County.

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12 SECTION 3

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14 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
15 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
16 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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18 SECTION 4

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20 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
21 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
22 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
23 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
24 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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
