A Resolution authorizing the County Executive execute any documents and take whatever other action is necessary to notify the Ohio Board of Building Standards and any other necessary State agencies that the County of Summit relinquishes its certification to enforce and inspect medical gas systems, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 4101:1 of the Ohio Administrative Code, a county building department may enforce the medical gas systems provisions of the Ohio Building Code, Ohio Mechanical Code and Ohio Plumbing Code, provided that it employs the requisite medical gas systems inspectors and applies for and obtains the certification of the Ohio Board of Building Standards, which certification the County of Summit completed in 2010; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has determined it is no longer in the best interest of the County of Summit to continue to engage in these inspections and therefore wishes to relinquish the County's certification to the Ohio Board of Building Standards to enforce and inspect medical gas systems; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4101:1, if a County elects not to continue to keep current the certification, the enforcement of medical gas inspections will be performed by the Ohio Division of Industrial Compliance; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute any documents and take whatever other action is necessary to notify the Ohio Board of Building Standards and any other necessary State agencies that the County of Summit relinquishes its certification to enforce and inspect medical gas systems;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized execute any documents and take whatever other action is necessary to notify the Ohio Board of Building Standards and any other necessary State agencies that the County of Summit relinquishes its certification to enforce and inspect medical gas systems.
