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13 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
14 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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16 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for 180 Ballistic Helmets
17 for Homeland Security Region 5 SWAT Teams, for an estimated total cost not to exceed
18 \$105,000.00; and

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20 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is on file in the Clerk of Council's office;

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23 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
24 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
25 advertise for bids for the aforementioned Ballistic Helmets for Homeland Security Region 5

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33 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for 180 Ballistic Helmets for
34 Homeland Security Region 5 SWAT Teams, for an estimated total cost not to exceed
35 \$105,000.00.

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39 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
40 of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
41 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for the aforementioned necessary equipment for
42 Homeland Security Region 5 SWAT Teams.
