A Resolution declaring it necessary to submit to the electors of the County of Summit the question of the renewal of an existing tax levy for the programs and services of the Summit County Developmental Disabilities Board ("the SCDDB") and requesting the County Fiscal Officer to certify to the taxing authority the total current tax valuation of the County and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a specified number of mills for the purpose of providing community developmental disabilities programs and services pursuant to Chapter 5126 of the Revised Code for the benefit of children and adults, for the SCDDB, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

This Council makes the following findings and determinations:

- (a) The Summit County Board of Development Disabilities (the "SCDDB") has requested this Council to submit to the voters the question of the renewal of its existing tax levy. (See, Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully restated). The SCDDB has requested the Social Services Advisory Board (the "SSAB") to review and approve its proposal for the Tax Levy (as defined below).
- (b) This Council is the taxing authority of Summit County under Section 5705.01. Ohio Revised Code.
- (c) The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of the SCDDB.
- (d) It is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation (the "Tax Levy") for the benefit of the Summit County Developmental Disabilities Board for the purpose of providing community developmental disabilities programs and services pursuant to Chapter 5126 of the Revised Code for the benefit of children and adults.

SECTION 2

The Tax Levy will have the following terms:

- (a) The Tax Levy will be levied under the authority of Sections 5705.19(L) and 5705.222, Revised Code.
- (b) The Tax Levy will be a renewal of an existing 4.50 mill levy to constitute a tax of 4.50 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to 45.0 cents for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation.

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SECTION 2 (Cont.)

(c) The Tax Levy will be for a six-year period of time, beginning on the tax list and duplicate for the year 2018. The proceeds of the tax levy would be distributed to the County in 2019 through 2024, inclusive.

SECTION 3

In accordance with Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, this Council authorizes and requests the Clerk of Council to certify a copy of this Resolution to the County Fiscal Officer to certify to this Council the total current tax valuation of the County and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the Tax Levy in the amount of 4.50 mills.

SECTION 4

Upon receipt of the County Fiscal Officer's certification and receipt of the SSAB's approval, this Council will consider for enactment legislation to submit the question of the Tax Levy to the voters at the November 7, 2017 general election.

SECTION 5

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately enable the County Fiscal Officer to calculate the amounts requested in Section 3 and to certify the question to the Board of Elections in time for the November 7, 2017 election.

SECTION 6

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the County Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 7

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
