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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**  
8 **accept an Ohio Statewide System Reform Program, Family Drug Courts Project grant**  
9 **from the Supreme Court of Ohio, for the period of 6/1/17 through 1/31/18, in the amount of**  
10 **\$20,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating these grant funds, for**  
11 **the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of Ohio has awarded the County of Summit Court of  
14 Common Pleas-Juvenile Division an Ohio Statewide System Reform Program, Family Drug  
15 Courts Project grant, for the period of 6/1/17 through 1/31/18, in the amount of \$20,000.00, with  
16 no local cash match requirement; and

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18 WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant establish a comprehensive strategy for statewide  
19 multisystem reform that improves outcomes for children and families in the child welfare system  
20 with substance abuse and mental health challenges; and

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22 WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division intends to use the grant funds  
23 to contract with Northeast Ohio Behavioral Health to provide trauma focused training to  
24 members of the Court, Summit County Children Services and the County of Summit Alcohol,  
25 Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board and to provide group therapy to the Court's  
26 Family Reunification through Recovery Court participants; and

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28 WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the County Executive to execute any documents  
29 necessary to accept the aforementioned grant and to appropriate these grant funds; and

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31 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
32 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County  
33 Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant  
34 from the Supreme Court of Ohio and to appropriate these grant funds;
