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WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest to authorize the County Executive to execute any documents necessary for the County Executive and County Engineer, on behalf of the County of Summit, to apply for CMAQ funds administered and programmed by AMATS and ODOT for the improvement of the Cleveland Massillon Road and Ridgewood Road intersection in Copley Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive and the County Engineer, on behalf of the County of Summit, are hereby authorized to apply for Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality ("CMAQ") funds administered and programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study ("AMATS") and the State of Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") for the improvement of the Cleveland Massillon Road and Ridgewood Road intersection located in Copley Township, in Council District 5, for which the construction costs are estimated to be \$350,000.00, with additional costs for rights-of-way (the "Project"). The Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for said CMAQ funds programmed by AMATS and ODOT for the Project.

SECTION 2

The County of Summit acknowledges and understands the AMATS "Funding Policy Guidelines" and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information contained in the project application is accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue that project, and that a local share is required to match federal funds.

SECTION 3

The Clerk of Council is instructed to provide two (2) certified copies of this Resolution to the Engineer, for submission to AMATS as part of the funding applications.

SECTION 4

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reasons that it will immediately allow the County to obtain grant funds for needed road improvements in Copley Township, in Council District 5.

SECTION 5

 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight (8) members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
